Intend of use for Endoscopy Channel Pre-Cleaning Detergent with Sponge of Kent Surgical®:

• A Cleaner for the initial flush and wipe of an endoscope.

Product Specification:

• Clear, Blue liquid. Non-flammable, with medical-grade foam Sponge.

General Safety Information:

- Read and follow these instructions and keep them accessible to the staff working with the product.
- The product should be used by trained and qualified personnel.
- The products must be used exclusively for the intended purpose by appropriately trained and qualified personnel.
- Wash thoroughly after handling.

Warning:

- Do not breathe vapor, mist, or spray.
- Use your Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) during using the product.
- If in Eyes; Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
- Do not use it if the package is damaged.
- Do not use the expired product.
- Store it between 5°C & 25°C.

Instructions For Use:

All scopes must be pre-cleaned with detergent, as soon as the endoscope has been removed from the patient. Before the endoscope is even detached from the light source or processor.

Each endoscope manufacturer will have slightly different guidelines on how to flush their scopes, but all are clear that this has to be carried out immediately after the procedure.




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- 1. Once the procedure is finished, Break the lid lock.
- 2. Open the Endoscopy Channel Pre-Cleaning Detergent pack.
- 3. Suction up the Endoscopy Channel Pre-Cleaning Detergent until the pack is empty.
- 4. Remove the scope sponge and wipe down the insertion tube.









STEP ONE

Break the lid lock.

STEP TWO

Open the easy-peel lid.

STEP THREE

Suction up the detergent until the pack is empty.

STEP FOUR

Remove the scope sponge & wipe down the insertion tube.
